FINANCIAL REPORT

Jeff introduced Treasurer Denise Hurtado and gave credit to Carolyn Jackson for finding such a perfect person to serve as our Treasurer. Denise expressed concern that it would be disruptive to have elections of new officers so soon in March. Jeff agreed that it has its benefits and its downside. We discussed that the slate would be temporary until March 2020 at which time we will have an election but for continuity's sake, we encourage allowing the current officers to remain.

Denise stated she would use Excel to do her treasurer's reports.

We realized our By-Laws were insufficient for denoting how monies were spent, so we added the caveat Under Article VI Paragraph B "Unbudgeted single expenditures must be approved by the President and the Treasurer up to \$500.00 and by the entire Board over \$500.00". We also need to include the requirement of posting an invoice or receipt for reimbursement. Kiki will re-draft the By-Laws and we will postpone signing them at this time. Kiki will send the updated By-Laws to the board.

We need to obtain receipts and/or invoices from people who are owed money. At our meeting, Mike J. was reimbursed for purchasing the decals.

WEBSITE


The website is now live. Jon needs more stories and action shots (as current as possible.)
